The HEVAR Team is delighted to announce that the Underfloor Heating Manufacturers Association (UHMA) will be hosting seminar sessions at Manchester HEVAR for the first time at the 2010 event.

On Wednesday 10th February, Chris Ingram, chairman of the UHMA will be presenting a seminar talk on the impact of the recognition of UFH as more energy efficient than radiators will have on heating engineers.

Attendees to the show on Thursday 11th February will be able to enjoy a whole morning dedicated to presentations from the UHMA. The session will be opened by Chris Ingram who will give a brief introduction to UFH and an overview of UFH efficiency. Bill McConnel, Technical Director of Continental UFH will follow on with a look at domestic properties and how UFH can be integrated into existing and new properties, including the implications of various choices of heat source. From a commercial property prospective, a representative from Wavin Underfloor Heating will be giving a presentation using case studies from Wavin where UFH has been used in commercial projects including schools and hospitals.

John Trenell, Technical Managing Director, Encompas will be covering integrating UFH with renewables – controls and good design is the key. Speaking after John will be David Pollard of BPEC who will be discussing how and where to get trained in UFH installation and design. For HVAC professionals interested in good practice in design & installation of UFH, the Code for Sustainable Homes, and the BSRIA guides to UFH should attend Reginald Brown's (Head of Energy & Environment, BSRIA) session.

The last twenty minutes of the morning will be dedicated to question and answers and panel discussions.
