**'Exhibitors take to the lectern at Manchester HEVAR'**

In addition to presentations from leading industry associations and organisations there will be seminars from exhibitors participating at Manchester HEVAR 2010.

First up to the lectern will be **Bernard Dawson of Riello Ltd**. Bernard will be presenting the case for liquid biofuel as an alternative low carbon heating solution to biomass. The talk will highlight the advantages of liquid biofuel combustion over that of biomass and deal in general with the potential for the utilisation of this fuel in new and existing heating systems. He will present the current position with regard to Riello burner tests and developments including their involvement in the recent trials with a local authority.

The CPD accredited seminar session from **Bryan Barlow, Sales Director of Spirotech** (UK) Ltd will cover energy efficient wet systems and the well known problems created in the commissioning phase and how it will not take place with correct water management utilising efficient and effective deaeration to eliminate delays and setbacks to the Hand Over date.

Discussing dynamic balancing (methodologies, instrumentation and balancing large & small terminal units) / TA Scope will be **Graeme Waugh of Tour & Andersson**. The TA- Scope which is being launched at the exhibition is a wireless, handheld and user-friendly instrument designed to verify, measure and balance the flow, differential pressure, temperature and power of complex systems efficiently. Hydronic networks can be created with the TA-SCOPE, which integrates with TA-Balance software to aid trouble-shooting and data logging. An independent sensor communicates with the TA-SCOPE to deliver data quickly, thereby enabling contractors to balance a system, troubleshoot hydronic problems and log system performance.
